Under the Licensing Act 2003, anyone authorising the retail sale of alcohol must hold a personal licence.

In order to qualify for a personal licence, an applicant must hold a licensing qualification which is: Qualifications and Curriculum Authority (QCA) accredited, and Government approved.

In order to be eligible to apply for a personal licence a person must:

- Be 18 years of age or above
- Not have forfeited a personal licence in the preceding 5 year period
- Must not have any unspent convictions for any relevant offences in either England or Wales or for any foreign offences.
