Fees:

Your course may be fully funded if you are aged 19 - 23 and this is your first Level 3 qualification. Fees for 2018 entry are approximately £3,500, this is usually confirmed by the Skills Funding Agency in April/May each year. For anyone who is 19 years or over, you can apply for an Advanced Learning Loan to cover tuition fee costs. You do not have to repay the loan until you are earning a minimum of £21,000 a year, (it is anticipated this will rise to £25,000 a year from April 2018 as part of a change in Government policy).

The loan may also be written off by the Student Loans Company if you go on to complete a full higher education qualification. The College also has a limited bursary fund to support people from low income families with costs such as childcare and transport, please contact us on 0330 123 2523 for more details.


